Housing Incentive Program

Home Purchase

- Free **water and sewer** for 1 year (up to \$360)*
- Two free city **trees** (\$25)
- 18 holes of **golf & cart rental** at New Rockford Golf Course (\$45)
- Free DPRCA **theatre tickets** (\$25/ticket)***
- Free 1-month **gym pass** to Rockin' Fitness (\$39 single, \$65 couple)

NEW RESIDENT BONUS:

- Free family season **swimming pass** at the New Rockford Pool (\$100)
- 2 Adult **School activity passes** (\$85)

New Construction

- Free **water and sewer** for 1 year (up to \$360)*
- City lots available for **\$5.00 per frontal** foot plus specials
- **Building permit** fees waived (up to \$150)
- 2-year **abatement** on real estate taxes***
- Two free city **trees** (\$25)

*Actual usage up to \$360, or for a maximum 12 month period, whichever is reached first

**One DPRCA ticket per person in family, up to 4

***Tax abatement is offered on the first \$150,000 of value, not including land—This is in accordance to ND Century Code 57-02-08(35)

Home Renovation

- **Building permit** fees waived (up to \$150)
- 5-year property **tax exemption** on added value, per city assessor

To apply, call or stop in at the **NRABC office in City Hall** to pick up a short application form.

Your application must be received and approved prior to submitting a building permit request or closing on a home purchase.
