Eligible participants: Property owners within city of New Rockford

Tree Size Requirements: Trees must be 5' or larger upon purchase



Maintenance: Property owners are responsible for ND One Call (www.ndonecall.com OR 1-800-795-0555), planting, mulching, watering, and any necessary pruning. Keep mowers and trimmers away from the trunk of your tree. This damage is irreversible and will cause eventual death. Place a ring of mulch or place plastic tubing around the tree to increase survivability. Follow proper planting diagram, available from City Hall.

Placement: Trees must be placed on the boulevard, 12' from driveways and alleys, 25' from existing trees, and on corner lots-30' from the point of intersection of the curbs. Boulevards must be at least 6' wide.

Reimbursement: Participants must follow program guidelines. Provide proof of purchase from licensed nursery for reimbursement of 50% of tree cost, up to \$75. Plantings of potted trees can be successful all season, but the program is on a first come-first served basis, subject to limitation of available program funds.
