




Respect Memory Permanence Sympathy

The **Women's Auxiliary Cemetery Association** is a non-profit, volunteer board that is responsible for the maintenance and groundskeeping of the Prairie Home and St. John's Cemeteries, located one mile north of New Rockford. Our duties include employing a groundskeeper, and maintaining structures, equipment, grounds, roads, and trees.

We ask that you please consider making a gift in support of the perpetual care of the cemeteries. Donations may be made in your own name, in memory or honor of someone else, or anonymously.



The two cemeteries, along with the veterans' memorial dedicated to the servicemen and servicewomen of our armed forces, cover a total of about 23 acres, including almost 3600 gravesites and several hundred trees. A full-time groundskeeper is employed during the summer to maintain these grounds.



The Women's Auxiliary Cemetery Association was founded in 1954 for the collective perpetual care of both cemeteries, and is dedicated to keeping the cemetery grounds safe and beautiful in honor of those interred and for the peace of their loved ones.

Our organization operates entirely from memorials, donations, and grant writing. Support is received from Prairie Home and St. John's Cemetery Associations, but we do not receive direct funding from the purchase of cemetery lots, nor from taxes, city, county, state, or federal funds.
