The Eddy County Courthouse doors will remain locked until the next commissioners meeting on June 2, 2020. The Eddy County Commissioners will re-visit opening the courthouse at that meeting. Patrons may come to the courthouse to conduct business by appointment only. They will be encouraged to utilize other options, such as phone, mail, or email, whenever possible. There are signs posted on the front and back door of the courthouse with the phone number and extension for each department.

The State of North Dakota has some temporary positions available for RNs, LPNs and laboratory technicians. They are also looking for volunteers to help with the fight against Covid-19.
