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Important Information About Your Drinking Water

The City of New Rockford Did Not Meeting Monitoring/Reporting Requirements for Chlorine/Chloramine Residuals

The City of New Rockford is required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. Records show that the City of New Rockford did not collect/report the required number of chlorine/chloramine residual samples that were to be taken at the same time and location as total coliform samples for April – June 2024; and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.

Please share this information with all the other people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (for example, people in apartments, nursing homes, schools, and businesses). You can do this by posting this notice in a public place or distributing copies by hand or mail.

There is nothing you need to do at this time; however, as our customer you have a right to know what happened and what we are doing to correct this situation.

The City of New Rockford regrets that this error in meeting monitoring/reporting requirements of the Stage 2 Disinfectants/Disinfection Byproducts Rule occurred. It is recognized that a complete monitoring program is of great value in making certain that safe drinking water is provided to all consumers.

Steps have been taken to ensure that adequate monitoring/reporting will be performed in the future.

The City of New Rockford collected the required samples but failed to report the findings to the State of North Dakota before the deadline. The samples were within all the legal limits required by the State of North Dakota.
