RANGE RULES

1. All shooting must cease before targets are checked on all ranges.
2. All firearms not on the firing line must be holstered or unloaded with their action open and the magazine removed or unloaded.
3. Before participating in organized events all shooters must sign a RANGE RELEASE WAIVER, HARMLESS INDEMNIFICATION AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK AGREEMENT before shooting.
4. Owners of Class III firearms must be in possession of any special permits or paperwork required by law.
5. Food, beverages, and tobacco products are prohibited in the range area. No smoking in the range building.
6. All calibers of pistols are accepted.
7. Rifles up to and including .460 Weatherby Magnum Caliber may be fired. Caliber .460 and larger must use the 400 yard range unless prior authorization is acquired.
8. Cross firing of targets is prohibited.
9. All firing from the 25 yard line must be aimed fire unless prior authorization is acquired.
10. Shooters may collect brass that is on or behind the firing line. Brass from other shooters and all brass that falls in front of the firing line may not be collected unless authorized by the Range Officer during events.
11. Competitions held on the Eddy County Rod & Gun Club range will be done in accordance with rules of the sanctioning body of the match.
12. Range officers reserve the right to inspect any firearms or ammunition for safety considerations.
13. Paper targets and commercially purchased silhouette targets only are allowed unless prior authorization is acquired.
14. Decisions by the range officer are final.
15. Commands issued by the Range officers and other Range Personnel must be obeyed immediately.
16. When the command "Cease Fire" is given all shooters must stop shooting immediately, remove your finger from the trigger, keep firearms pointed in a safe direction and wait for further instructions from the Range Officer.
17. No one may go forward of the firing line unless authorized or instructed to do so by the Range Officer during events.
18. When the line is declared "CLEAR". All firearms must be holstered or unloaded benched or grounded with the muzzle pointed down range with the action open ejection port or cylinder up and magazine removed. All shooter must step back from the firing line. No firearms may be handled while the line is clear.
19. Use the appropriate size target, placed at eye level to ensure that your shots strike the backstop. Firing shots that result in bullets striking anything other than the target and backstop may result in damage or repair costs that are charged to the shooter and is cause for removal from the range.
